Air-permeable and breathable, Sandler nonwovens also contribute to an optimal micro-climate of the seat, for pleasant and productive working, in summer and winter.

Sandler polyester nonwovens for increased comfort and optimum sound insulation in the office were in high demand at this year's Orgatec. Sandler's acoustically efficient nonwoven panels are an ideal solution for frameless partition walls, which currently are all the rage. The textile alternatives for acoustically efficient interior design elements were a drawcard, particularly for potential new customers.
